

Qualifications and Requirements

1. Professor (under Surya Kumar Bhuyan School of Social Sciences– 1 (One) post

The applicant must be either of the following discipline:-

Economics/Education/History/ Philosophy/ Political Science/ Sociology/ Social Work/Education Innovation and Teacher Training

Essential qualification (A or B):

A.

i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC – listed journals and a total score of 120 as per the criteria given in Annexure I.

ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Desirable qualification:

i) A degree/Diploma in distance education or working experience in distance education Institution.

ii) Adequate knowledge of Computer.

iii) Proficiency in both Assamese and English Languages.

2.Professor (under Padmanath Gohain Baruah School of Humanities)– 1 (One) post

Assamese/ English/ Sanskrit and Ancient Studies

Essential qualification (A or B):

- i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC – listed journals and a total score of 120 as per the criteria given in Annexure I.
- ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

- i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a

minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC – listed journals and a total score of 120 as per the criteria given in Annexure I.

ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Desirable qualification:

i) A degree/Diploma in distance education or working experience in distance education Institution.

ii) Adequate knowledge of Computer.

iii) Proficiency in both Assamese and English Languages.

Any discipline of Science and Technology

Essential qualification (A or B):

A.

i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC – listed journals and a total score of 120 as per the criteria given in Annexure I.

ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Desirable qualification:

- i) A degree/Diploma in distance education or working experience in distance education Institution.

5. Associate Professor

Essential qualification:

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale, wherever grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/Industry with a minimum of seven publications in the Peer-reviewed or UGC- listed journals and the total research score of Seventy Five (75) as per the criteria given in Annexure I.

Desirable qualification:

- i) A Degree/Diploma in distance education or working experience in distance education Institution.
- ii) Adequate knowledge of Computer.
- iii) Proficiency in both Assamese and English Languages.

Scale of pay: Rs. 1,31,400 – 2,17,100 (Academic Level 13A)

(Pay to be fixed as per UGC guidelines and fixation formula)

Age: As per State Government Rule

6. Assistant Professor

Essential qualification:

A.

i) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale, wherever grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. The Gazette of India: Extraordinary [Part III-Sec.4].

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the NET conducted by UGC or CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded Ph.D Degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-Laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirements of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions –

- a) The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode.
- b) The Ph.D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners.
- c) An open Ph.D viva-voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programms in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

The Ph.D degree obtained from a foreign University/Institution with a ranking among top %) in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

(i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Sanghai).

Note: the Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for colleges of the UGC Regulations, 2018, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

7. Assistant Regional Director

Essential qualifications:

A. i) Consistently good academic records with at least 55% of the marks, or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Masters Degree level from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the NET conducted by UGC or CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded Ph.D Degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-Laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirements of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions –

- a) The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode.
- b) The Ph.D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners.
- c) An open Ph.D viva-voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programms in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
