

### **Guidelines for Psychological Practical, BA Education**

The learners who are pursuing Bachelor's Degree in Education are to perform Psychological Practical in the 13<sup>th</sup> Paper. They are to perform Psychological Experiments as mentioned in the Self Learning Material (BED M 13).

The SLM of this paper is provided in English Medium only. Learners can conduct the experiments both in English and Assamese languages according to their own choices.

A minimum of 10 experiments are to be done during the semester period.

Four (4) experiments with the help of Apparatus

Three (3) experiments without the help of Apparatus

Three (3) Physiological experiments or Drawing

All the practical experiments are to be recorded in a Note Book and the same should be submitted to the University for Evaluation.

The Study centre should have the following materials ready in their Psychological Laboratory-

- (i) Supportive Instrument for Mirror Drawing Apparatus
- (ii) Tachistoscope (Falling door apparatus)
- (iii) Memory Drum
- (iv) Punch Board
