GUIDELINES FOR DISSERTATION WORK IN MA EDUCATION,

4th Semester (Paper 16)

- 1. Full Marks 100
- 2. Out of 100, 80 Marks are allotted for dissertation and 20 Marks for Viva-Voce.
 - a) Viva-voce will be based on the work of dissertation. It will also cover questions on research methodology and the recent developments in research studies in the subject.
 - b) The Viva-voce will be conducted by the university at specified centres.
 - c) The concerned faculty member of the department should supervise the preparation of the dissertation during the semester period.
 - d) The External Supervisor will conduct the Viva Voce. He or she should be a senior faculty member from any affiliated colleges. The External Supervisor will be appointed by the University.
 - e) Not more than 5 learners will be guided under one Supervisor at the same time.
 - f) A token of honorarium (500 Rs per learner) will be provided for the supervision.
- A Challan of Rs 1000/- as dissertation fees should be enclosed with the copy of the dissertation (which will be sent to the university), if not paid the fee during the admission time.
- 4. The coordinator with the help of faculty of Education Department should evolve the topic of dissertation from among broad topics and issues mentioned below.
- 5. Each learner should work on only one topic as assigned by the faculty. No two or more learner shall take the same topic.
- 6. The selection of the topics should include the following areas, matters and issues:
 - a) Challenges of education at primary; secondary and higher education.
 - b) Relevance of SSA, RMSA, RUSH for universalisation of education

- c) To find out how the training helps the teachers to improve their effectiveness of teaching at the primary and secondary level.
- d) Quality teaching is related to the academic achievements of learners.
- e) Environmental education and population education makes the learners aware of healthy and peaceful living.
- f) To find the strategies for improving the infrastructure and management system of the school or the educational institutions.
- g) Gender studies, women empowerment through education
- h) To study the differences between private and Govt. schools in terms of student's performance.
- i) To study the use of ICT in ODL as well as in conventional mode of learning for enhancing the quality of education.
- 7. The Coordinator of the study centre shall inform the university regarding the title of the topics soon against name of the candidates.
- 8. Three copies of dissertation should be carried by the learners while they come for the Viva-Voce in the university or in the respective Examination centre.
- 9. The copies of dissertation should be –one for the Study Centre, one for the University and one copy for the concerned learner/ candidate.
- 10. The dissertation should be field based and be prepared with the help of suitable methodologies. It should be an action based research.
- 11. The dissertation will be evaluated by the University. As such all the dissertations should be submitted to the university well ahead of time.
- 12. The Supervisor should follow the model of the certificate which is available in the University website.
