Guidelines for Psychological Practical, MA Education

The learners who are pursuing Master Degree in Education are to perform Psychological Practical in 12th Paper. They are to perform Psychological Experiments as mentioned in the Self Learning Material (MED 12).

A minimum of 12 experiments are to be done during the semester period.

Five (5) experiments with the help of Apparatus

Four (4) experiments without the help of Apparatus

Three (3) Physiological experiments

All the practical experiments are to be recorded in Note Book and the same should be submitted to the University for Evaluation.

The Study centre should have the following materials in their Psychological Laboratory-

- (i) Supportive Instrument for Mirror Drawing Apparatus
- (ii) Tachistoscope (Falling door apparatus)
- (iii) Memory Drum
- (iv) Level of Aspiration
- (v) Punch Board


