

## **REPORT OF THE ALUMNI MEET**

An Alumni Meet was held on March 5, 2024 in the Auditorium of the University at 2.30 pm. The first part of the formal meeting started with the University Anthem. The occasion was graced by the presence of the Vice Chancellor of the university Prof. (Dr.) Rajendra Parasad Das, Member of Teacher Selection Committee Dr. Uma Shankar Sarma, Member of the Board of Management, Dr. B.L. Choudhury, Registrar (i/c) Prof. Pranjit Bora, Prof (Dr.) Pranab Saikia, Controller of Examination Dr. B.R Sarma, Prof. N.N. Sarma, outgoing President Dr. Ajanta Das on the dais.

The Meet began with the felicitation of the Vice Chancellor by Registrar (i/c) Dr. Pranjit Bora followed by the welcome address by Prof. Pranjit Bora. Prof. Bora spoke in brief on the meaningful bonds that can be nurtured as Alumnis through the Association. The opening remarks was offered by Dr. Pranab Saikia who elaborately described about the need of Alumni Association. In the meeting all the dignitaries spoke few words about the formation and role of Alumni Association. Dr, Ajanta Das described about the work done during her tenure and the challenges faced to fulfil all the expected programme due to Covid pandemic. Vice Chancellor of the university Prof. (Dr.) Rajendra Parasad Das, in his concluding address elaborately described about the need of formation of Alumni Association. He also stressed to work together for the betterment of the university. He assured help to strengthen the Alumni Association. He also mentioned that the University will shortly establish four (4) Regional Centre at Jorhat, Lakhimpur, Bongaigaon and Silchar and appealed to the Alumnis to extend all possible support both in letter and spirit for the progress of the University.

The second part of the Meet was the Open Session held exclusively among the Alumnis. The session commenced with Dr. Ajanta Das officially resigning from her role as President of the Alumni Association and passing the responsibilities to the newly elected President, Sashadhar Deka. The names of the newly selected office bearers of the Association were announce and formally introduced to the gathering. According to the approved list office bearers are as follows-

This was followed by speech by Sashadhar Deka who spoke about the work programme of Association, role, responsibility of the Alumni. He stressed on the need of the betterment of Association. In his speech, he stressed on the role Alumni can play a crucial role in the growth and development of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) due to various factors. Alumni fulfil diverse roles effectively, including promoting institutional branding, providing mentorship to current students, facilitating internships, career opportunities, and job placements for graduates. He mentioned the role of Alumnis in the growth of their alma mater through ways like- i) Recruiting students. ii) Promoting educational programs. iii) Supporting professional integration and career advancement. iv) Fundraising. v) Unifying the community. He laid down his vision and spoke about his plan for the next year where he stressed on fostering connecting, archiving alumni data, engaging in social service, organizing seminars, publishing

books and bulletins, providing career and employment counselling, request for an alumni office to the authority, holding regular meetings, amending the constitution, celebrating institutional milestones, and fostering the holistic well-being of alumni members. Interaction was encouraged and one Alumnus Biswajit Bora spoke on his association with KKHSOU and his desire to work for the Association. Dr. Sukmaya Lama offered the vote of thanks towards the end of the Meet.
