

**Minutes of the First Committee Meeting of
YOVA Tourism Club (YTC) of KKHSOU**

In the light of the letter received from the Director of Higher Education, the meeting discussed the following.

Discussion:

- a. The formation of a tourism club at the University, comprising faculty members and learners, holds substantial potential for nurturing a constructive culture among the state's youth. Members expressed the belief that this initiative would additionally foster leadership qualities among the learners.
- b. The University's efforts to incorporate travel and tourism into the curriculum will provide learners with the opportunity to gain knowledge about the abundant natural and cultural travel heritage that the state possesses.
- c. The involvement of students from different study centres of the university as members of the tourism club assists in recognizing their individual talents and hobbies. These attributes are then synergized with tourism activities, effectively engaging learners in their respective locations.
- d. After deliberating on the creation of the tourism club, the meeting arrived at the following resolutions.


Resolutions:

- a. Creation of an official email ID for the proposed Yuba Tourism Club of the University.
- b. Development of a webpage on the university's website dedicated to disseminating notifications and important details concerning the activities and events organised by the committee.
- c. Generate a Google Form for the purpose of enrolling University learners into the Yuba Tourism Club.



- d. Place a flex containing the official QR code of the club at the University's reception counter to effectively communicate information about the club. This initiative is intended to boost member registrations.
- e. Conduct visits to nearby locations to identify potential tourism sites, and subsequently create a comprehensive project report aimed at the development of tourism within the chosen areas.
- f. The resolution entails that the Committee will employ a Google Form to establish communication with learners concerning the tourism club by the end of August 2023.
